Many of you have come to me with questions regarding the details of our Youth Mission to Nashville, Tennessee, from July 21st—July 25th, 2010. I hope this flyer is able to give you a better idea of what the week is all about.

WHY WOULD I WANT TO GO ON THIS MISSION?

This week is a wonderful opportunity to grow in community, make new friends, and do the work of God through serving our neighbors. Missions were, and continue to be, an influential part of my spiritual journey. Regardless of the location or details, I always return home with an added sense of appreciation for the many blessings in my life. Join us—as we are called by God to lend a hand to those in need.

WHAT OUTREACH WORK WILL WE BE DOING DURING OUR MISSION?

We have a variety of outreach opportunities planned for the mission. Some examples include working at a soup kitchen by preparing and distributing food to the homeless, and working in a thrift house, sorting the clothes and assisting shoppers.

WILL I RECEIVE COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS?

Yes! You will receive a letter confirming a total of 20 hours of community service after our mission to Nashville, Tennessee.

WHAT ACTIVITIES WILL WE BE DOING BESIDES MISSION WORK?

We have several fun activities planned for our mission. We will spend one night at the movies, another night bowling, and another night hanging out in downtown Nashville. Also, we will go to a local recreation center to soak in the pool after a hard day's work on Saturday. It is important for us to end of the day with some relaxation and fellowship.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO GO ON THIS MISSION?

All you need is a heart for service and be a *rising* 8th—12th grade student.

WHAT WILL A TYPICAL MISSION DAY LOOK LIKE?

We typically will wake up early and have breakfast to begin our day. We then depart for our first work site. After some lunch, we will depart for our second work site of the day. Remaining on the second site until mid-afternoon, we then return to our retreat center to relax and get prepared for our evening recreational activity. Each night will close with a devotional and Bible Study centered around the theme for the weekend.

WHAT IS THE THEME FOR THE WEEKEND?

Our Youth Mission theme is *Joy of Judgment*. We will spend the week exploring passages of judgment in the Bible and learn how it intends to nurture divine relationship.

I HAVEN'T BEEN INVOLVED WITH THE CATHEDRAL YOUTH GROUP OR HAVEN'T COME LATELY. SHOULD I STILL GO ON THIS MISSION?

Absolutely. Missions are a great opportunity to dive into the youth group experience. Yes, you can bring friends. And, no, you do not have to be a member of the Cathedral to attend. We welcome all *rising* 8th—12th grade students for this exciting week of service.

WHEN DO WE LEAVE? RETURN? TRANSPORTATION?

We will leave the Cathedral Wednesday, July 21st, at 1:15 PM. We return Sunday, July 25th at 3:00 PM. We will be driven by our sponsors in 15-passenger school activity buses from *American Van Rental*.

WHERE ARE WE STAYING? WHAT ARE THE SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS? SHOWERING FACILITIES?

We will stay at *Scarritt Bennett*, a retreat facility located in the heart of midtown Nashville, adjacent to Vanderbilt University. We will be sleeping in hotel-style rooms, with adjoining showering facilities between rooms. Towels and linens are provided by the center. (www.scarrittbennett.org; 615.340.7500)
