

MUSIC AT THE CATHEDRAL OF ST. PHILIP 2009-2010



The Cathedral of St. Philip is pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Dale Adelman as Canon for Music. Adelman received degrees from the University of Michigan and from the Institute of Sacred Music and School of Music at Yale University, with a doctoral degree from the University of Cambridge, England.

While at Cambridge, he was the first North American to serve as a choral scholar in the Choir of St.

John's College, then under the direction of George Guest. He also served as the musical director of the "Gentlemen of St. John's," a professional vocal ensemble comprised of the choral scholars from the St. John's choir.

Dale's previous positions have included Organist & Choirmaster of St. Paul's Cathedral in Buffalo, New York; Music Director of the Buffalo Philharmonic Chorus; and Music Director of All Saints' Episcopal Church in Beverly Hills, California. His organ teachers have included Marilyn Mason, Thomas Murray, and Peter Hurford.
